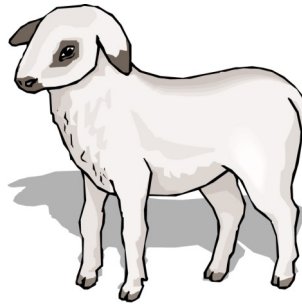
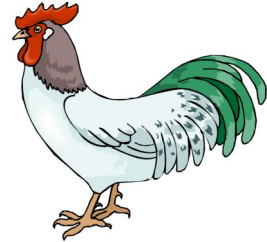


Flag of England



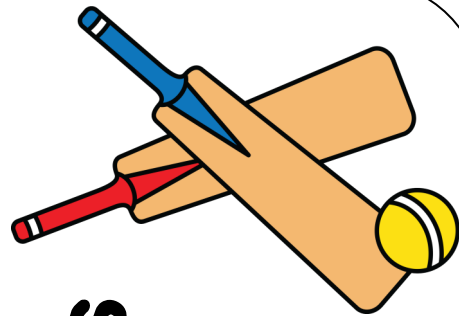
Directions: Cut out book out as one piece. Fold in half. Cut out flag. Color. Paste inside book. Older students may want to write a few flag facts in the book as well.

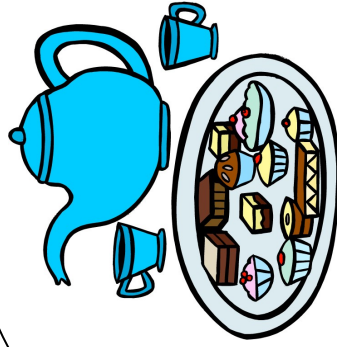


Directions: Cut out each book as one piece. Fold in half.

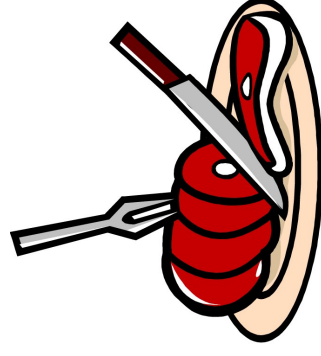
Popular Sports
