

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

Cut out pages (6 total). Stack together with cover on top and staple on the left side of the book as indicated.




Cut out pages (4 total). Stack together with cover on top and staple on the left side of the book as indicated.



Weather Comparison










Cut out book as one piece. Fold in thirds with cover on top. Unfold. Cut on dotted lines to form five flaps. Write information under the flaps.


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
Flag of England




Directions: Cut out book out as one piece. Fold in half. Cut out flag. Color. Paste inside book. Older students may want to write a few flag facts in the book as well.
