## Lapbook Activities

### 1. Sheep Picture

### 2. Vocabulary

Discuss the words in the nursery rhyme. Color, cut, and paste pictures to the layer book provided.

### 3. Phonics: Letter B Book

Introduce or review B. Create the B Book and add it to your lapbook.

### 4. What Is Blue? Wheel

Introduce or review the color blue. Find object around your house that are blue. Create the wheel and add it to your lapbook.

### 5. Lift the Flap Fun

Where is the little boy who looks after the sheep? Find out when you make this lift the flap book! Add it to your lapbook.

### 6. Cow Facts

Read books together about cows. Add your student's favorite cow facts to the pages of the mini-book. Add it to your lapbook.

### 7. Sheep Facts

Read books together about sheep. Add your student's favorite sheep facts to the pages of the mini-book. Add it to your lapbook.

### 8. Little Boy Blue Sequence Cards

Use these cards to help your student memorize the rhyme. You can also mix up the cards and ask your student to put them in order.

### 9. Color the Little Boy Blue Picture

### 10. Little Boy Blue Copywork

If your student enjoys (or is ready for) writing, choose one of the copywork books to complete.

### Recipe Idea: Make Haystacks!

#### Little Boy Blue's Haystacks

24 oz. butterscotch chips

6 oz. can chow mein noodles

Melt chips over low heat, stirring constantly. Remove from heat and stir in noodles until evenly coated. Drop by teaspoons onto waxed paper and chill.

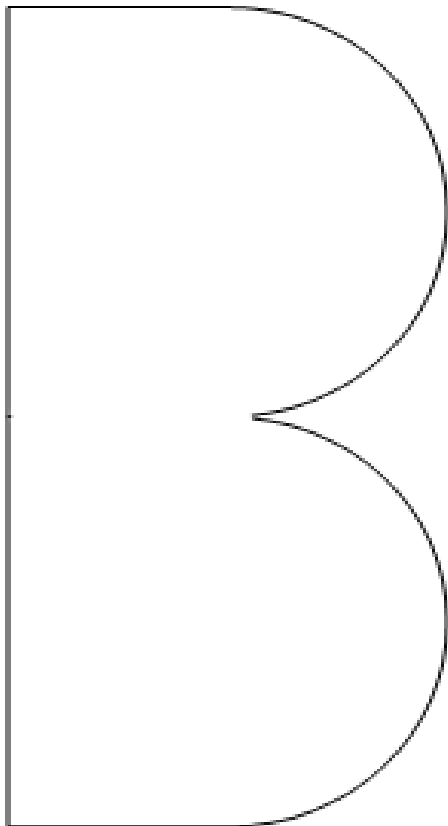
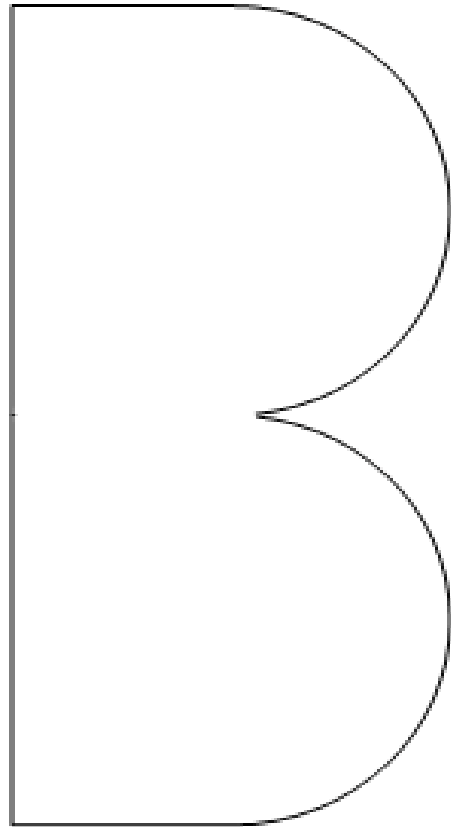
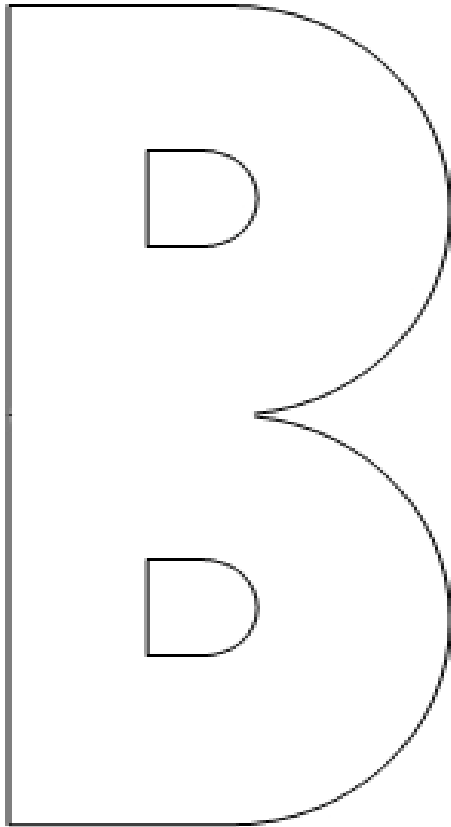
Cut rectangles out. Let your student find the correct picture to cut/paste on each page.

Stack rectangles in order from smallest to largest and staple at the top of the book.

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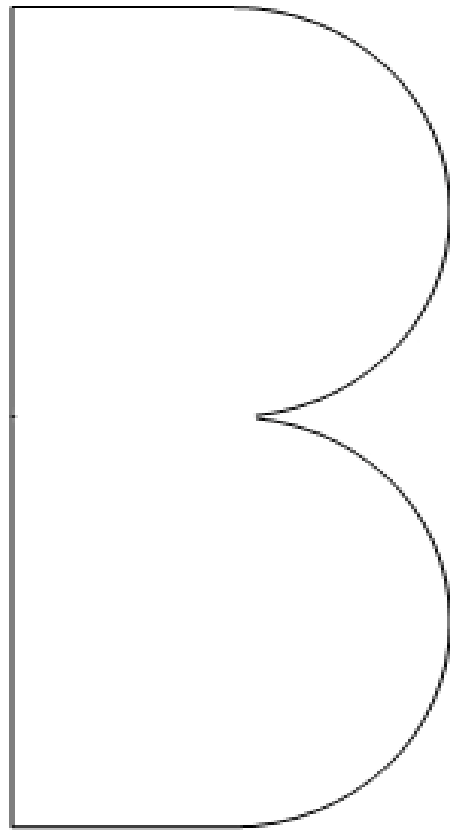
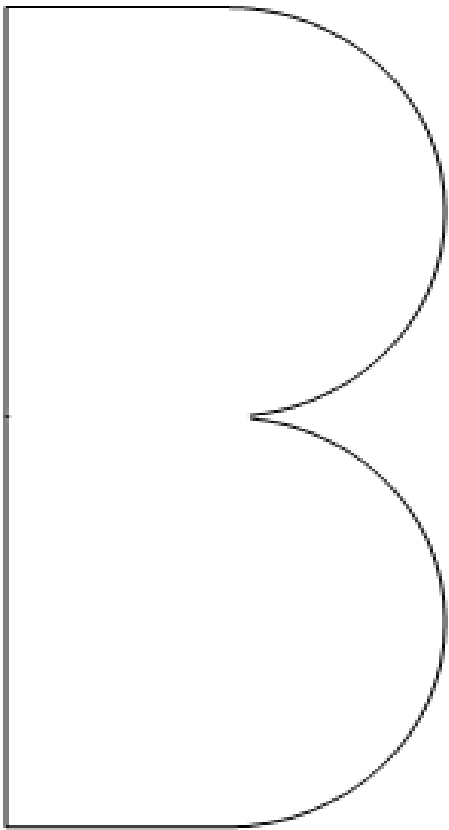
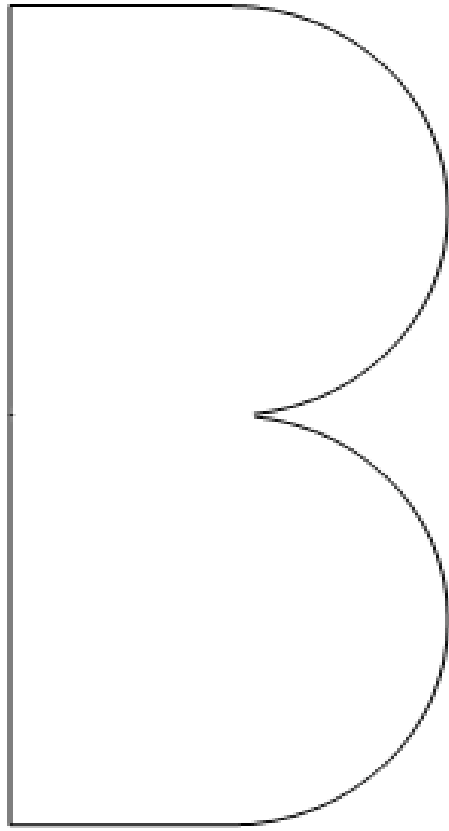
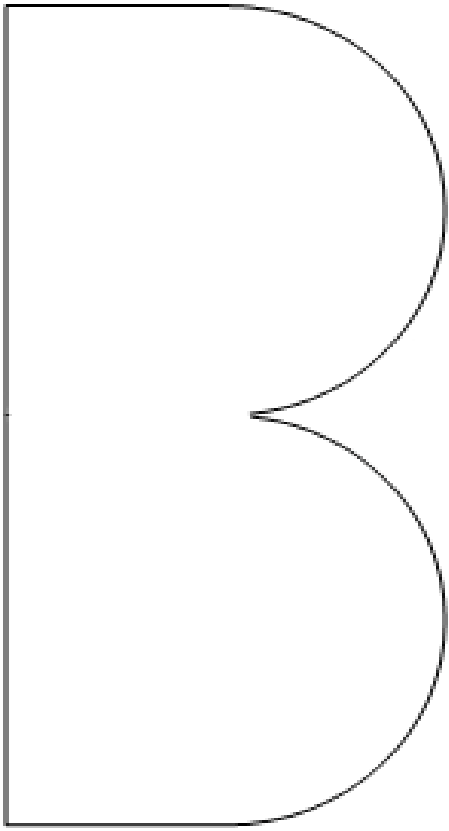




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Cut out stickers and stick them into the sections of the letter B shapes. Cut out all the shapes and staple them together like a letter B shaped book.



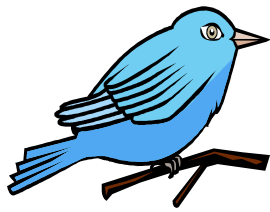
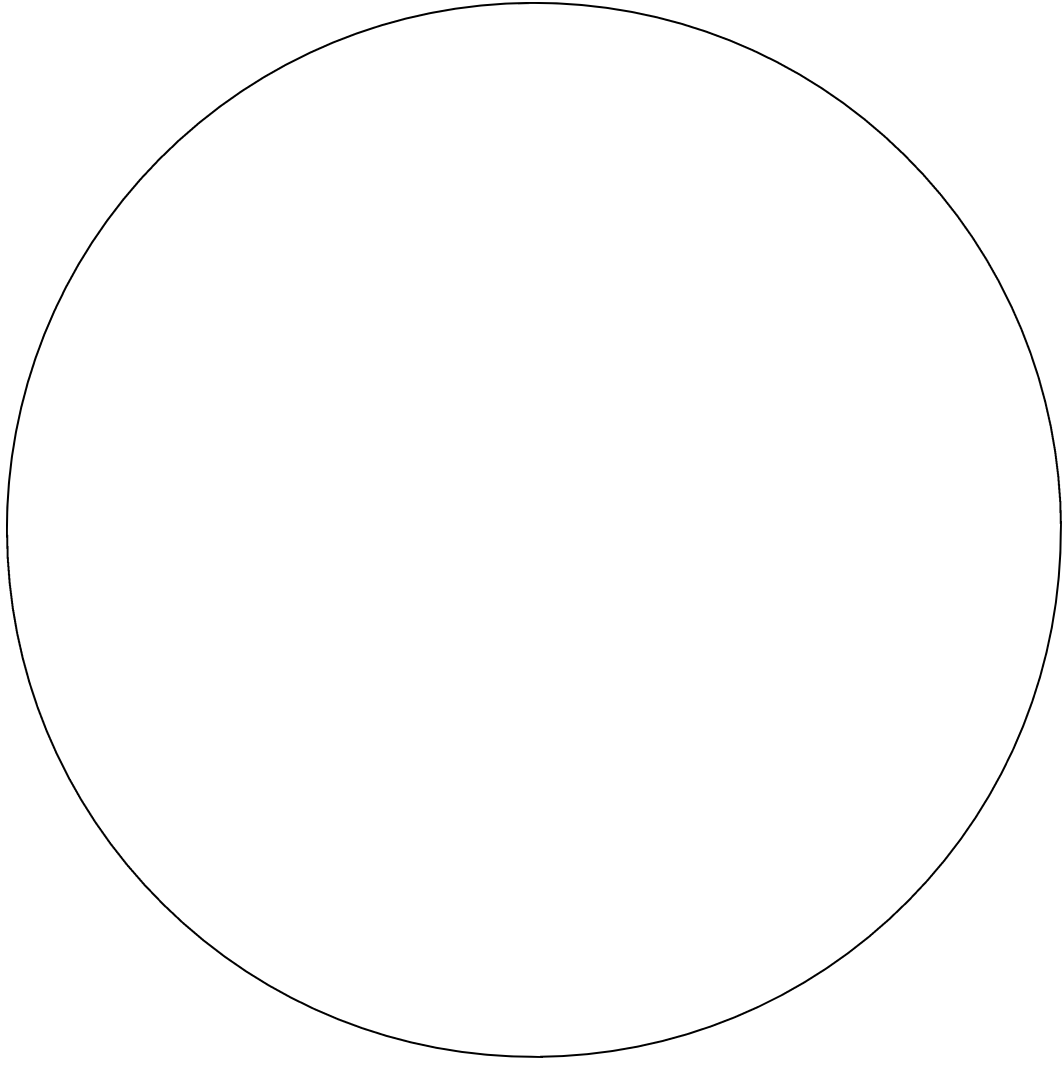


**NOTE: This page can be printed on sticker paper making the task easier than cutting and pasting for little hands. You can use Avery Full Sheet Labels—8165.**





Cut out wheels. Cut away the extra area on the cover wheel (where indicated). Let your student cut/paste the pictures on to the wheel. Attach wheels together using a brass fastener.

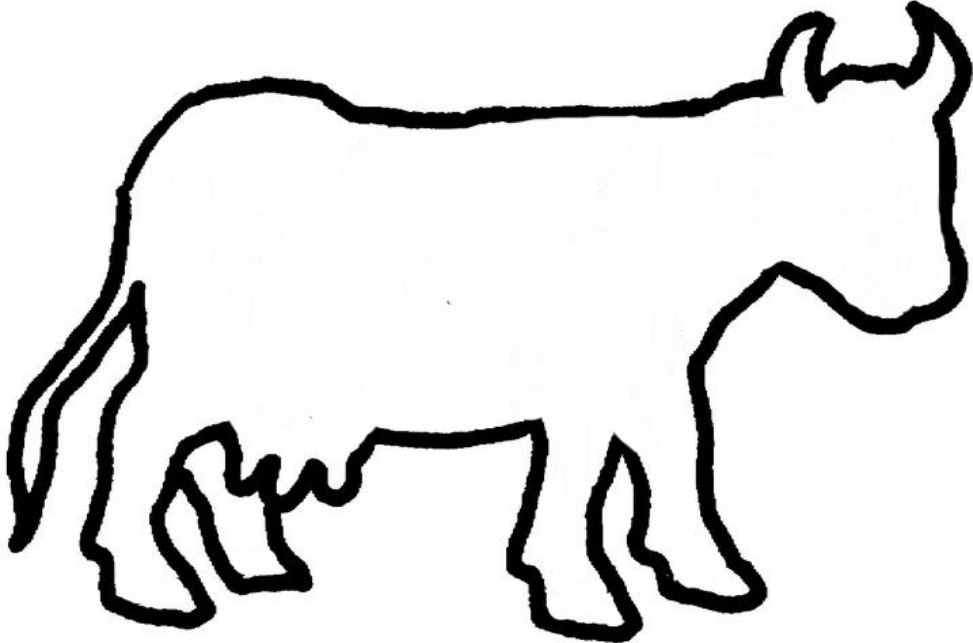
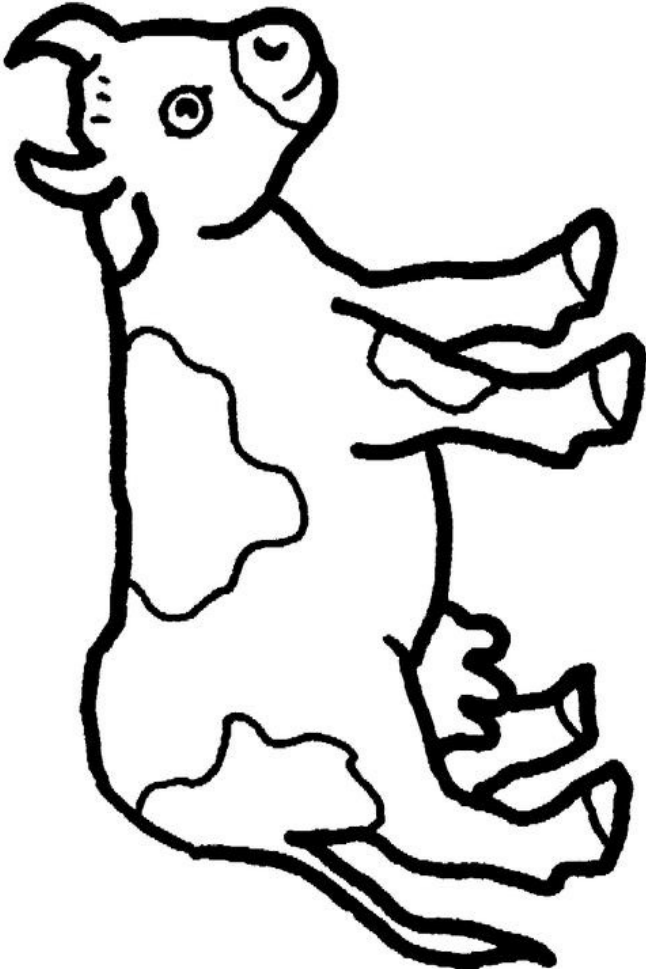




Cut out both pictures. Paste the haystack picture over the little boy picture so that it can be lifted up in answer to the question.

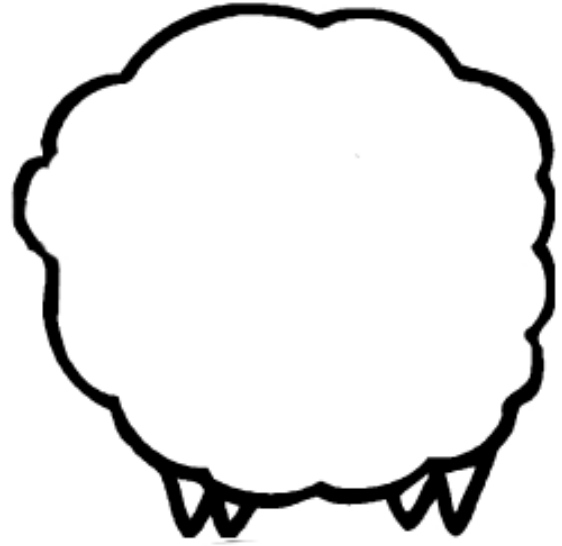
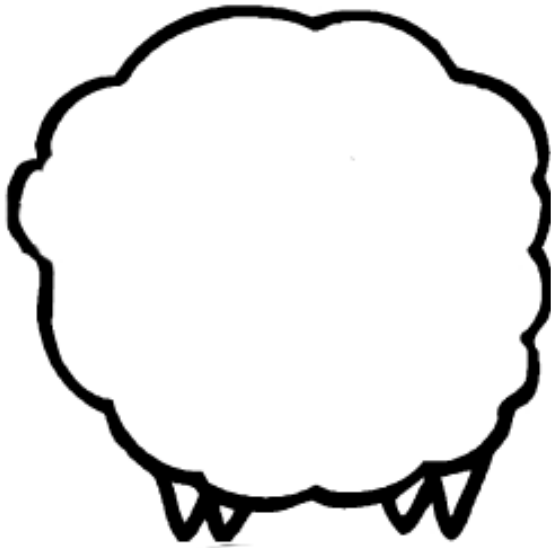
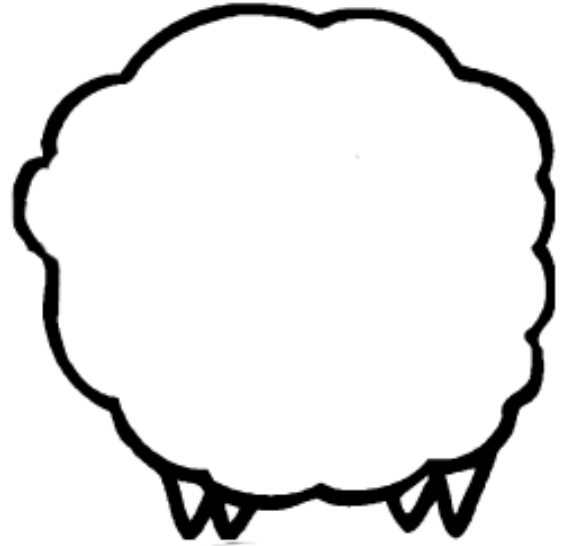
Cut pieces out. Stack together with cover on top and staple or use a brass fastener to secure.



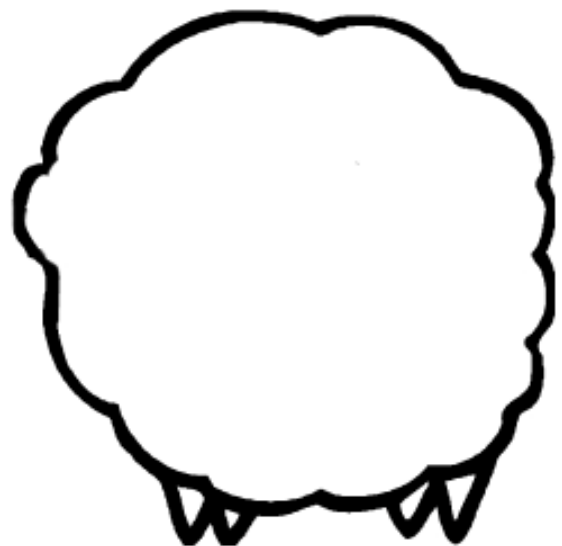
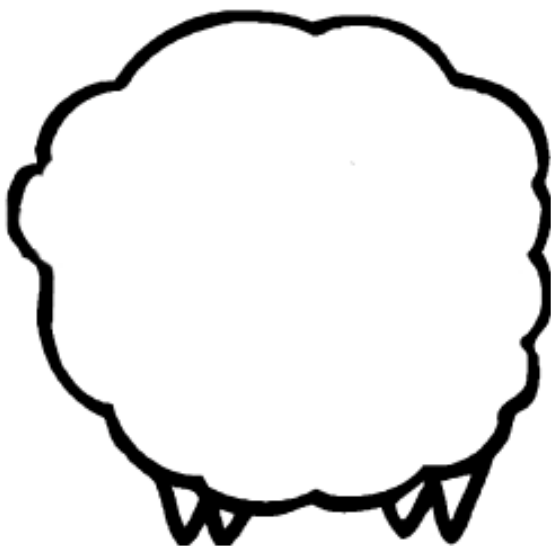
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Write or draw interesting facts about sheep. What are baby sheep called? What is wool used for? What do sheep eat? What are male and female sheep called?

# Little Boy Blue Story Cards

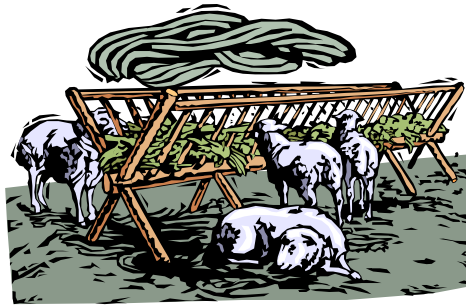


Cut out the folder and fold

pockets.

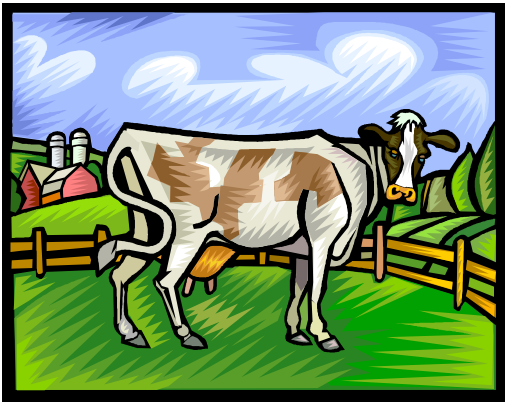

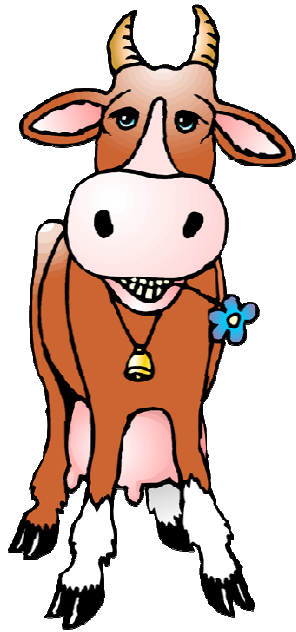

# Little Boy Blue Copywork



Little Boy Blue, come, blow your horn!

Handwriting practice lines consisting of three sets of solid top and bottom lines with a dotted midline.

Cut out each strip (one on this page and one the next) as one piece. Let your student complete the copywork. (For a young student, you may want to choose one line or a few key words). Attach extra pages by gluing the tab as indicated. Fold like an accordion. Tie a ribbon around the book, if desired (with the bow in the front); this will help keep it closed. Glue the back of the last page in to your lapbook.

Glue this tab to the back of the last page in your book.
